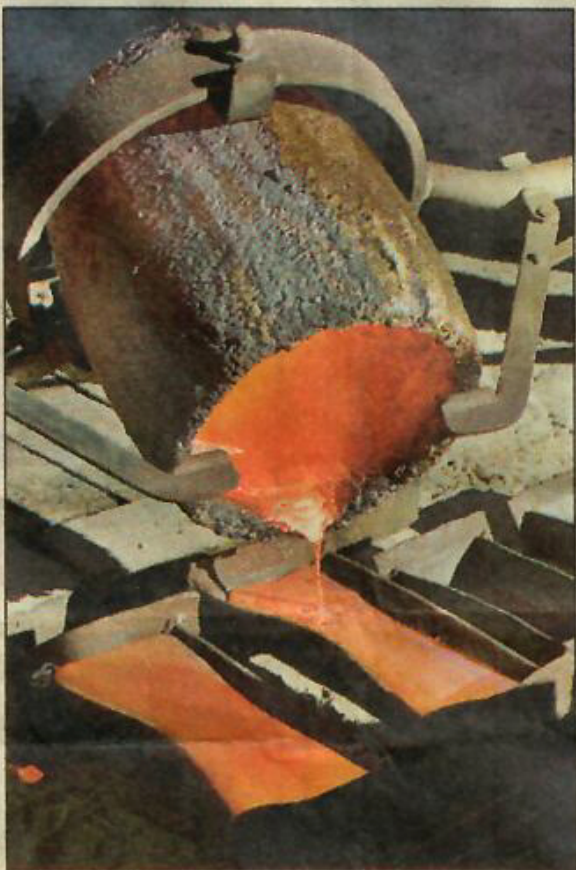


# BRONZING GREENE

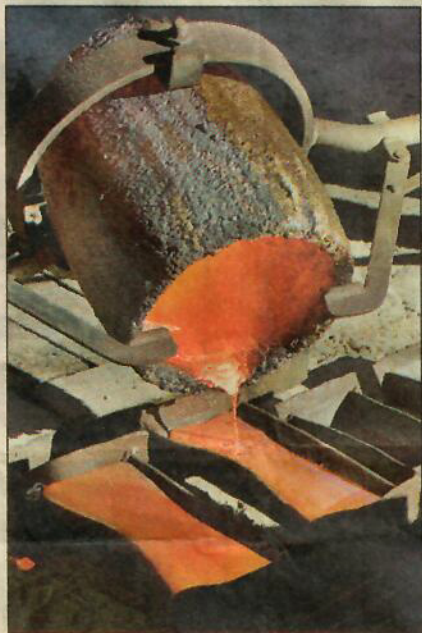
